



Proof of Age Application Instructions

Introduction

1. Proof of Age (POA) registration is compulsory for all skaters competing in divisions Preliminary and up and all Synchronized skaters including Adults.
2. The Ice Skating Australia (ISA) Proof of Age Register assists with establishing eligibility for all competitions and championships with age restrictions.
3. The Register is maintained by the POA officer nominated by the ISA Board of Management.
4. Registration is free of charge and recognized by all Members of ISA.
5. Proof of Age (POA) Number is issued as soon as practicable after receipt of a valid application.
6. Updates of the POA Register are made available to State Secretaries and relevant Operational Directors, at regular intervals.

Instructions

1. Print out a copy of the form. Electronically filled forms will not be accepted.
2. Use a black or blue pen to show up clearly on a scanned or faxed form.
3. Two Club, State or National officials must sight an original document such as a birth certificate or passport showing the skater's full name, date of birth, gender and nationality.
4. The signatories must not be related to either the skater or their coach.
5. Both parts of the application must be correctly filled out in full.
6. Please print clearly in BLOCK letters and check spelling and dates carefully.
7. Incomplete or illegible forms will not be processed.
